Visit Description (1/3)

Noor I visit

Legend :

1- 1st stop: control tower roof and control room (not considered as green areas).

2- 2nd stop: solar fields (GA3).

3- 3rd stop (on request): cooling towers (GA1).

GA Green Areas: wearing of PPE is not mandatory

Visit Description (2/3)

Noor I visit

- The previous diagram gives an overview of the Power Block of Noor I station.
- During the visit, visitors are accompanied to the roof of the control tower to get an aerial view of the entire solar field. They will have the opportunity to visit the control room to listen to more technical explanations (taking pictures is not allowed in this area).
- Visitors are then led to the solar field, where they can observe the CSP mirrors more closely.

Visit Description (3/3)

Noor II visit

For security reasons, the visit of Noor II is by bus only.

Noor III visit

For security reasons, the visit of Noor III is by bus. However, it is possible to get out of the bus in the green areas.

Two stops are planned: near the tower and near the heliostats.

R&D platform

Observation of technologies under test (in a 200 hectares field).

Logistics and safety instructions
